
Left Side Chaise with Hidden Storage, (Lsf arm and Lsf back cushion are stored in 2-seater)

Care Instruction for Boucle Furniture:

In order to maintain the original appearance of your Boucle furniture, please follow below simple care procedures:

- Avoid exposing furniture directly to sunlight or heating and air conditioning outlets. Sunlight and or exposure to heating and air conditioning outlets will fade/damage Boucle.
- Vacuum or wipe with a soft cloth to remove dust.
- Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check to make sure all connection are tight, re-tighten if necessary.



For item use on wooden floor, hard surfaces or carpets, it is recommended to install protective pads under all legs and supports to avoid/prevent from damages/scratches and discoloration.
