ITEM NO.: 8579SS-3 SOFA With 7 Pillows




Legs and hardware are stored at the bottom of sofa, please take out the legs and hardware for assembly.

NOTE: Do not use power tools for assembly. Power tools increase the risk of over tightening which leads to splitting or cracking the wood.





Care Instruction for Chenille Furniture.

In order to maintain the original appearance of your Chenille furniture, please follow below simple care procedures:

- Avoid exposing furniture directly to sunlight or heating and air conditioning outlets. Sunlight and/or exposure to heating and air conditioning outlets will fade/damage Chenille furniture.
- Do not place your upholstered furniture too close to windows, radiators, or vents and be sure to use window, radiators, or vents.
- Vacuum or wipe with a soft brush to remove dust.



For items used on wooden floor, hard surfaces or carpets, it is recommended to install protected pads under all legs supports to avoid/prevent from damages/ scratches discoloration.
